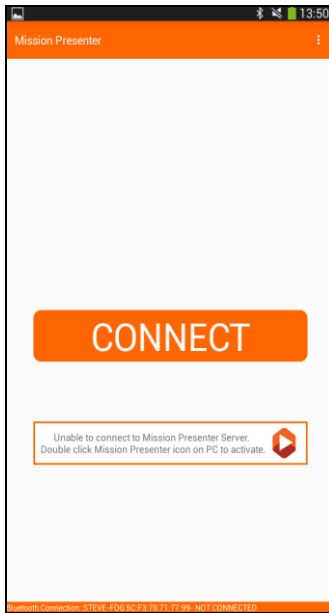


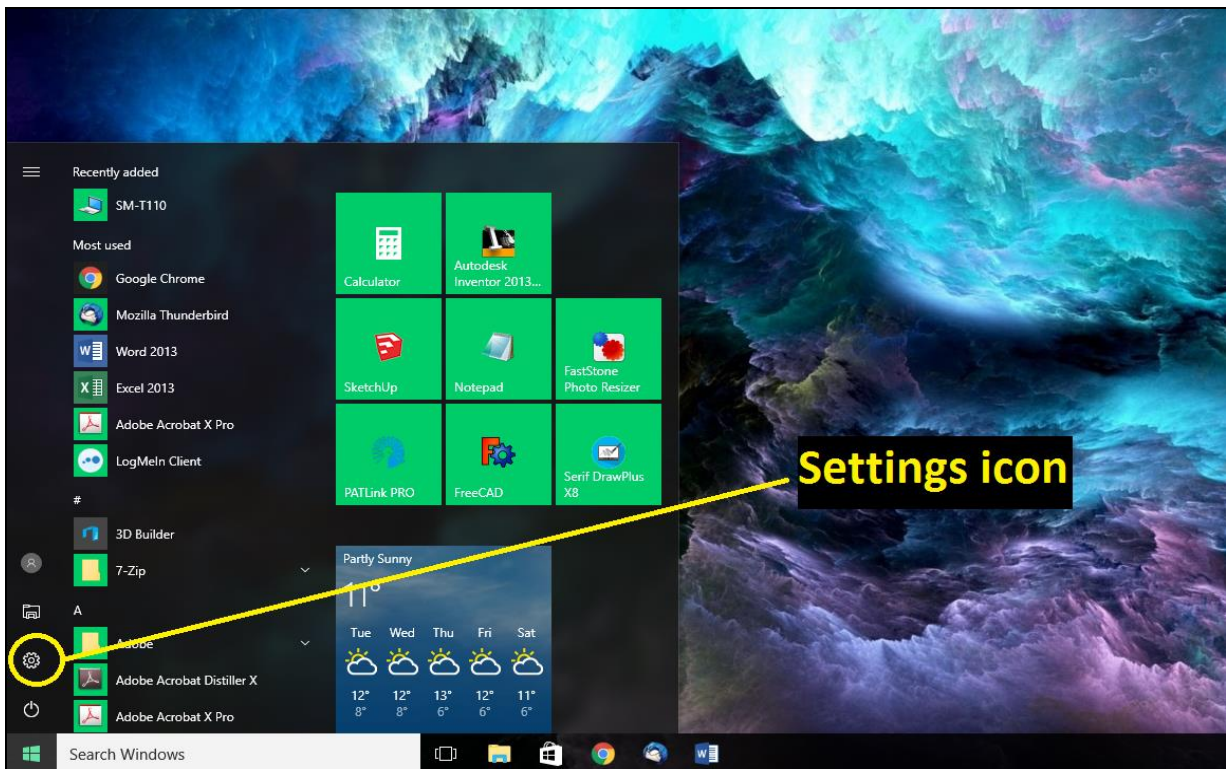
Bluetooth Re-pairing instructions



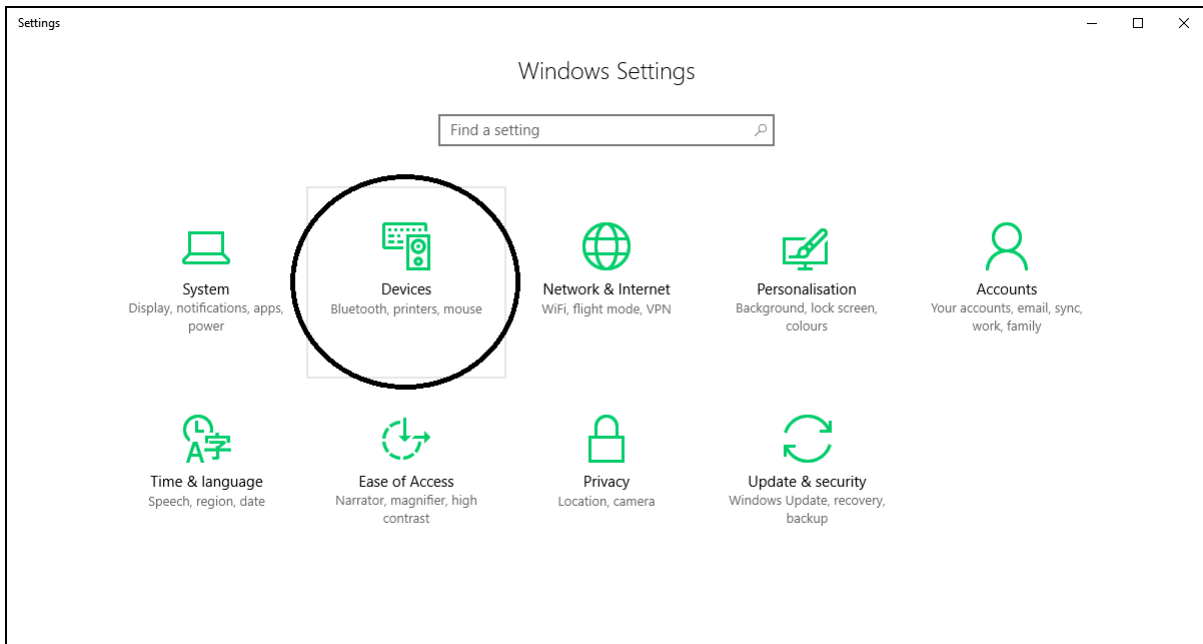
If you are seeing this screen on the tablet and double clicking the Presenter icon on the PC is not working then you may have to re-pair the tablet. The procedure to delete the existing pairing and re-pair the tablet is shown below.

Deleting the existing pairing

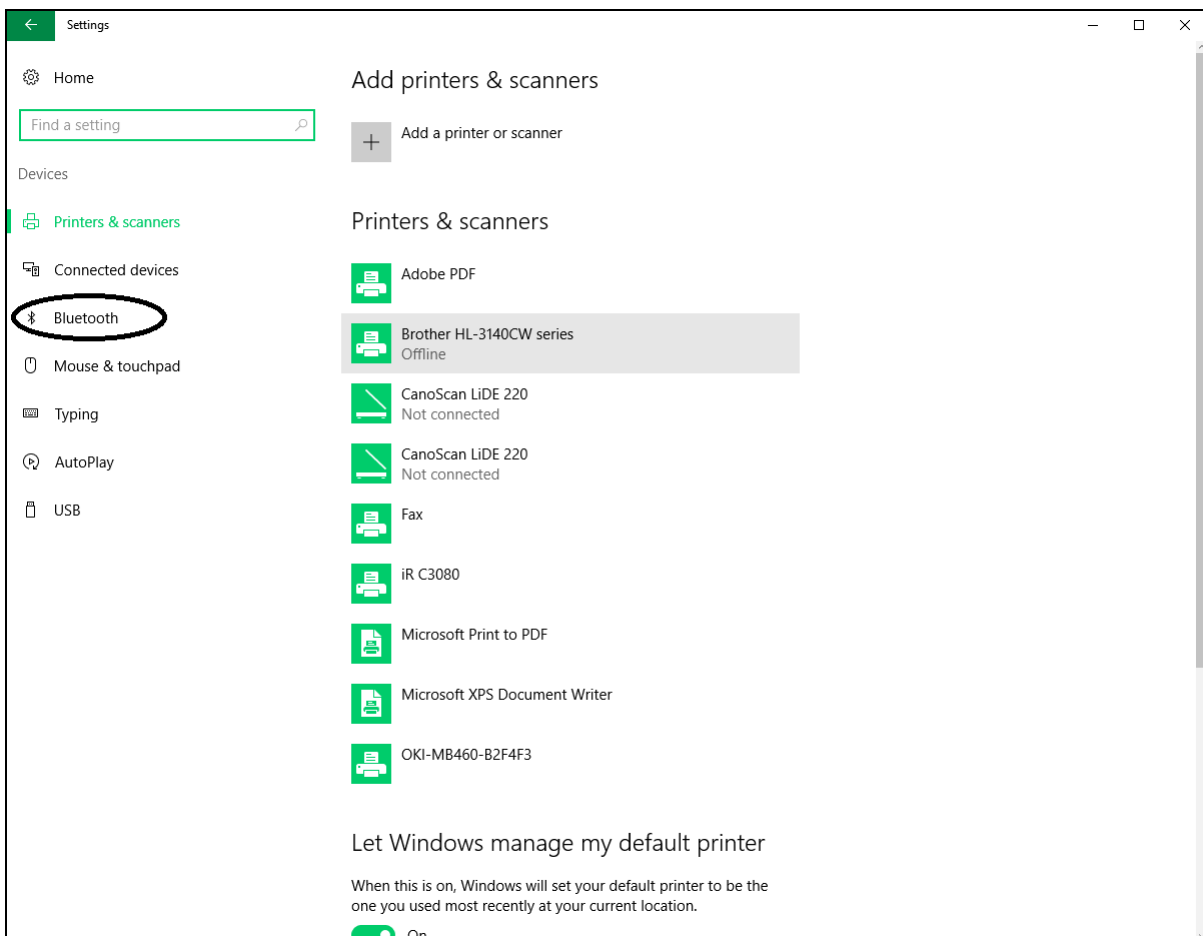
- Click the Start menu on the PC
- Select the settings icon



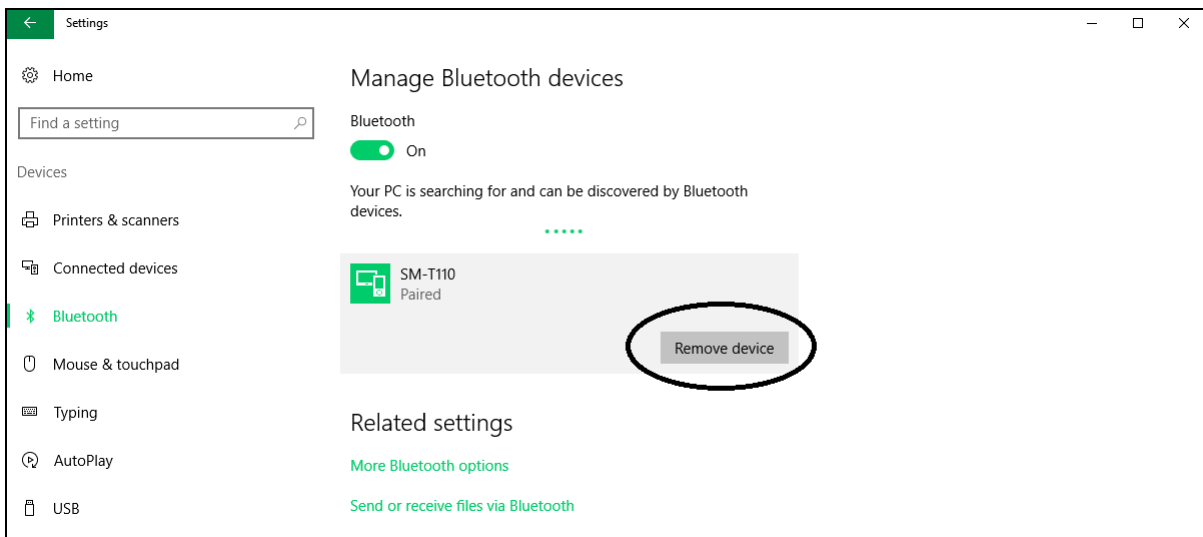
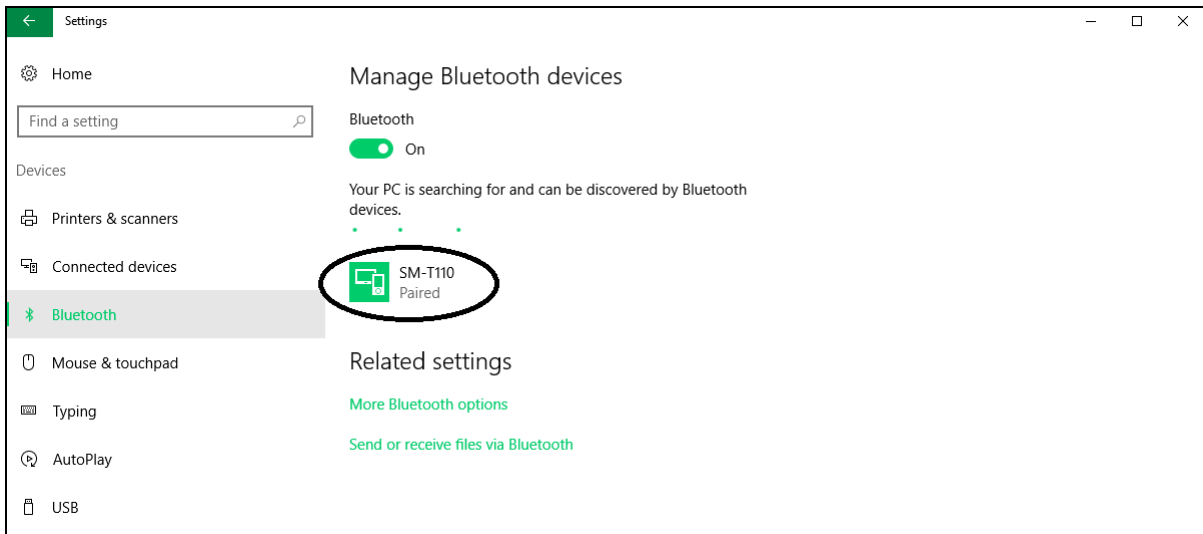
- Click on the section that is titled 'Devices'



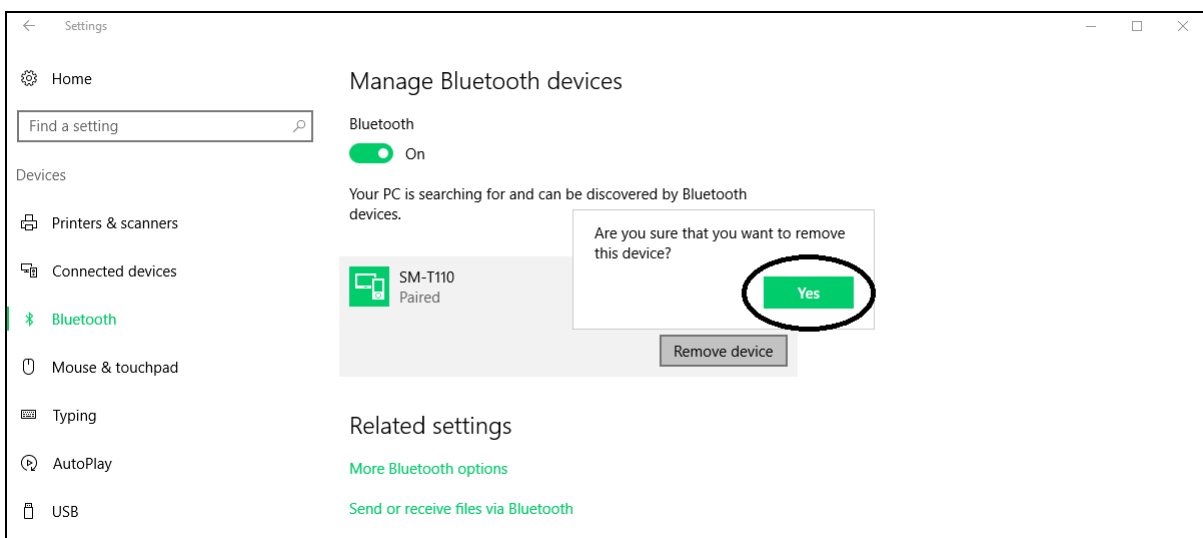
- On the left select 'Bluetooth'



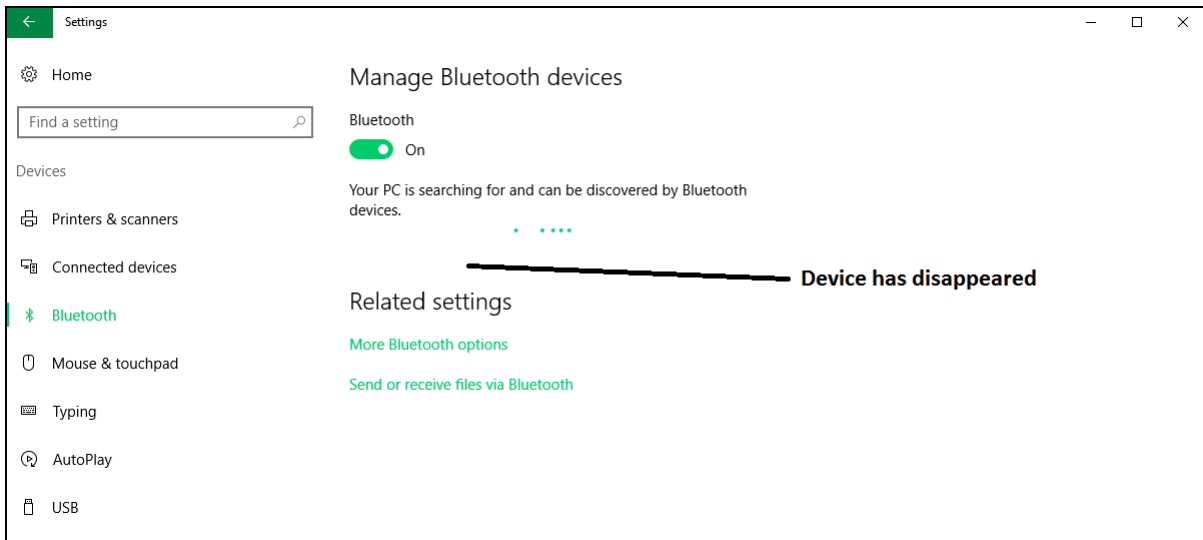
- Select the device and click on 'Remove Device'



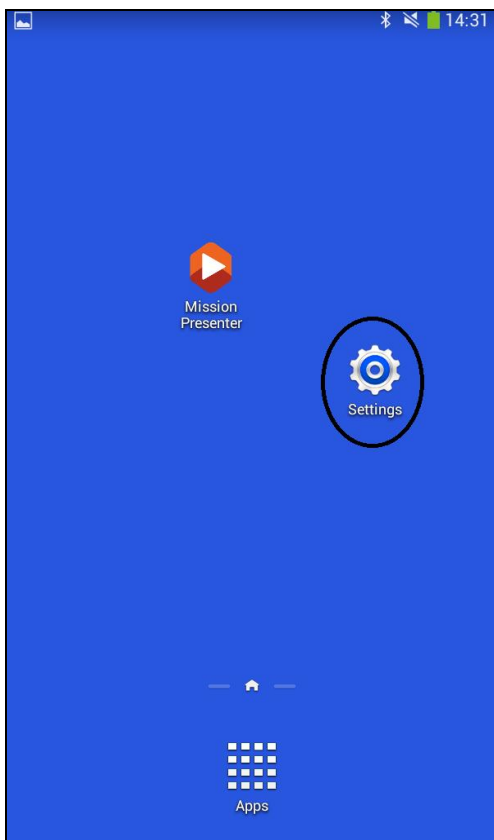
- Click 'Yes' to confirm that you wish to remove the device



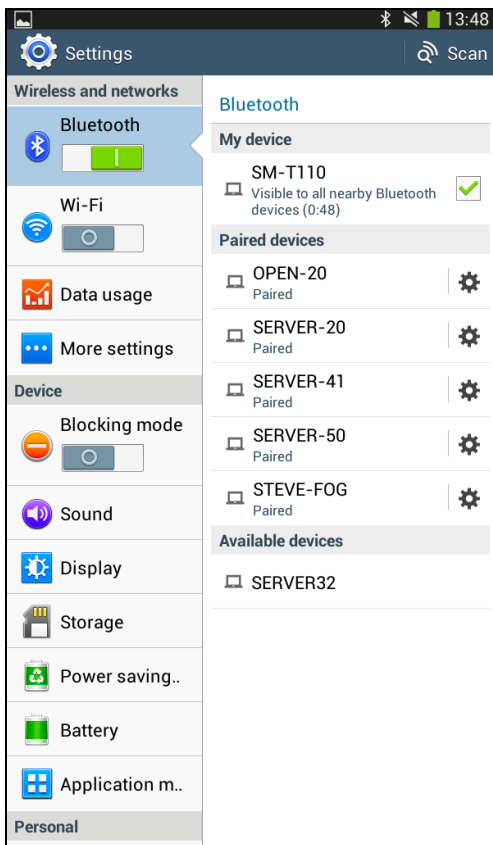
- The device will now have disappeared from the Bluetooth section



- On the tablet tap 'Settings'

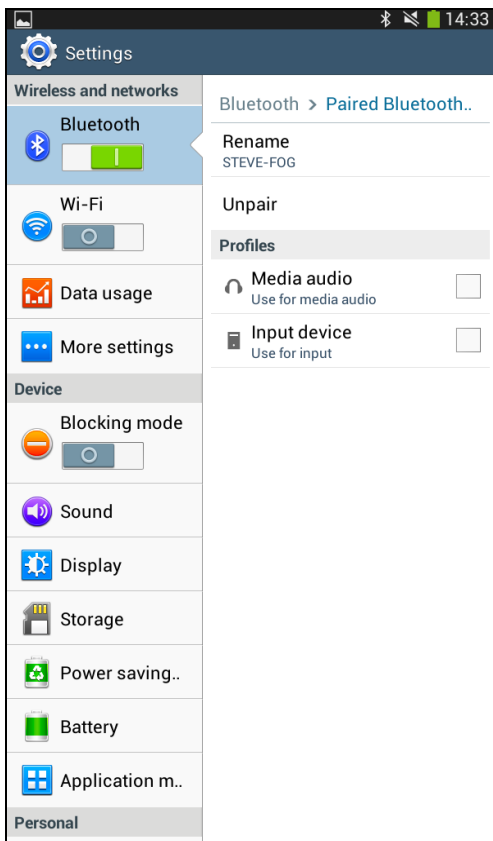


- Select 'Bluetooth' from the menu on the left

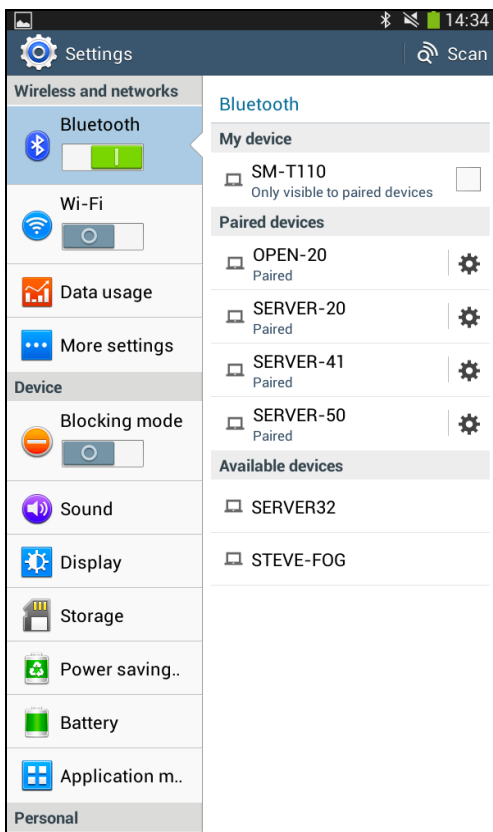


- Find the device name on the right under 'Paired devices'
- Tap the cog next to the name of the device

- On the next menu select 'Unpair'



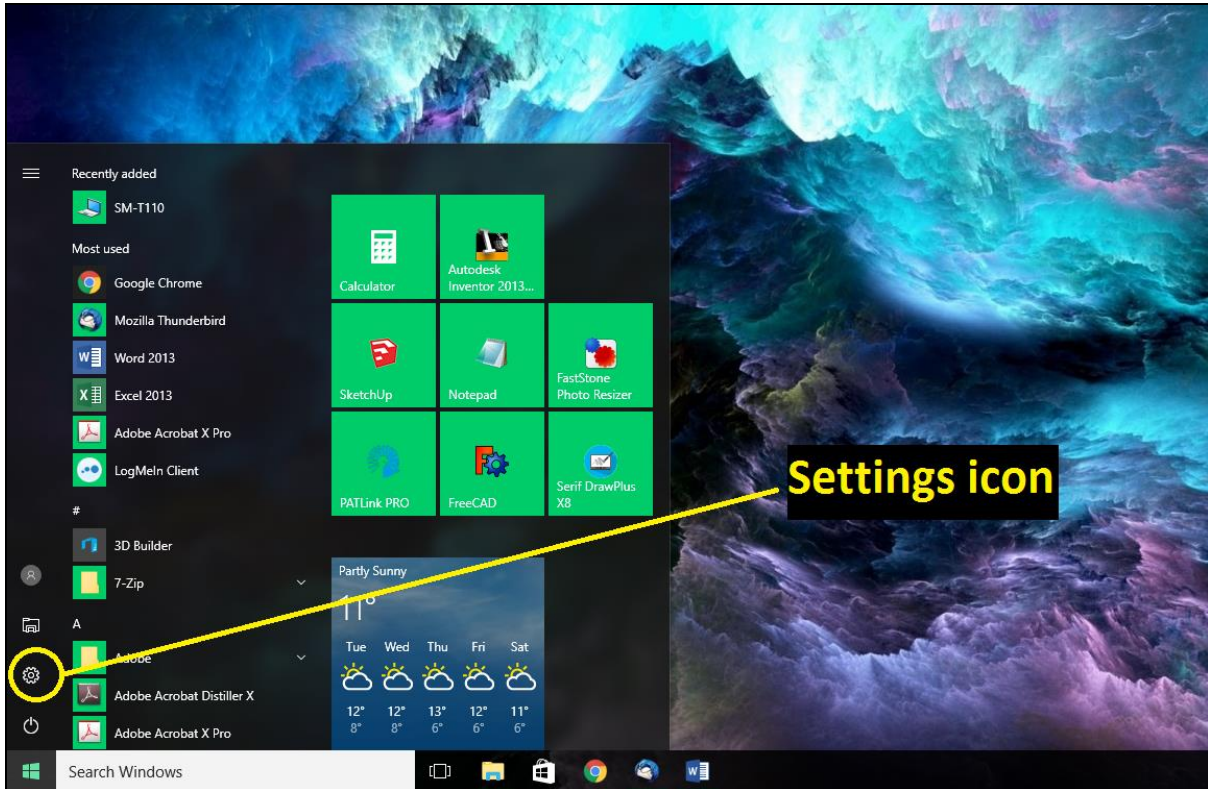
- The device will now have been removed from the 'Paired devices' section



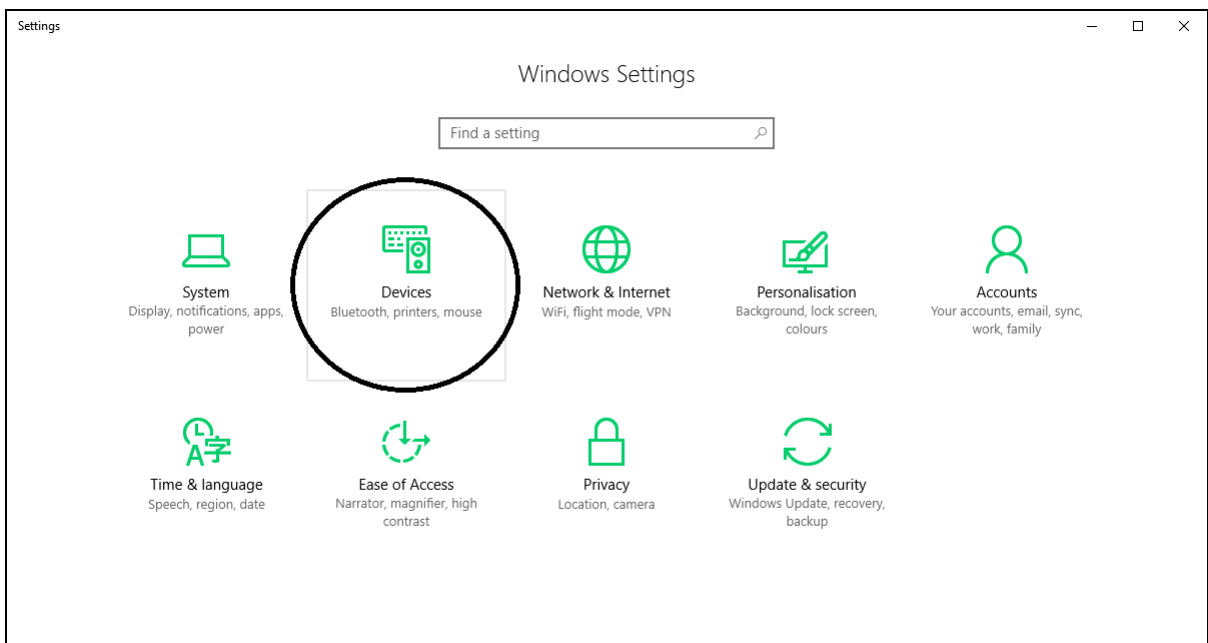
Now the pairings have been removed you can re-pair the handset with the PC

Pairing the handset

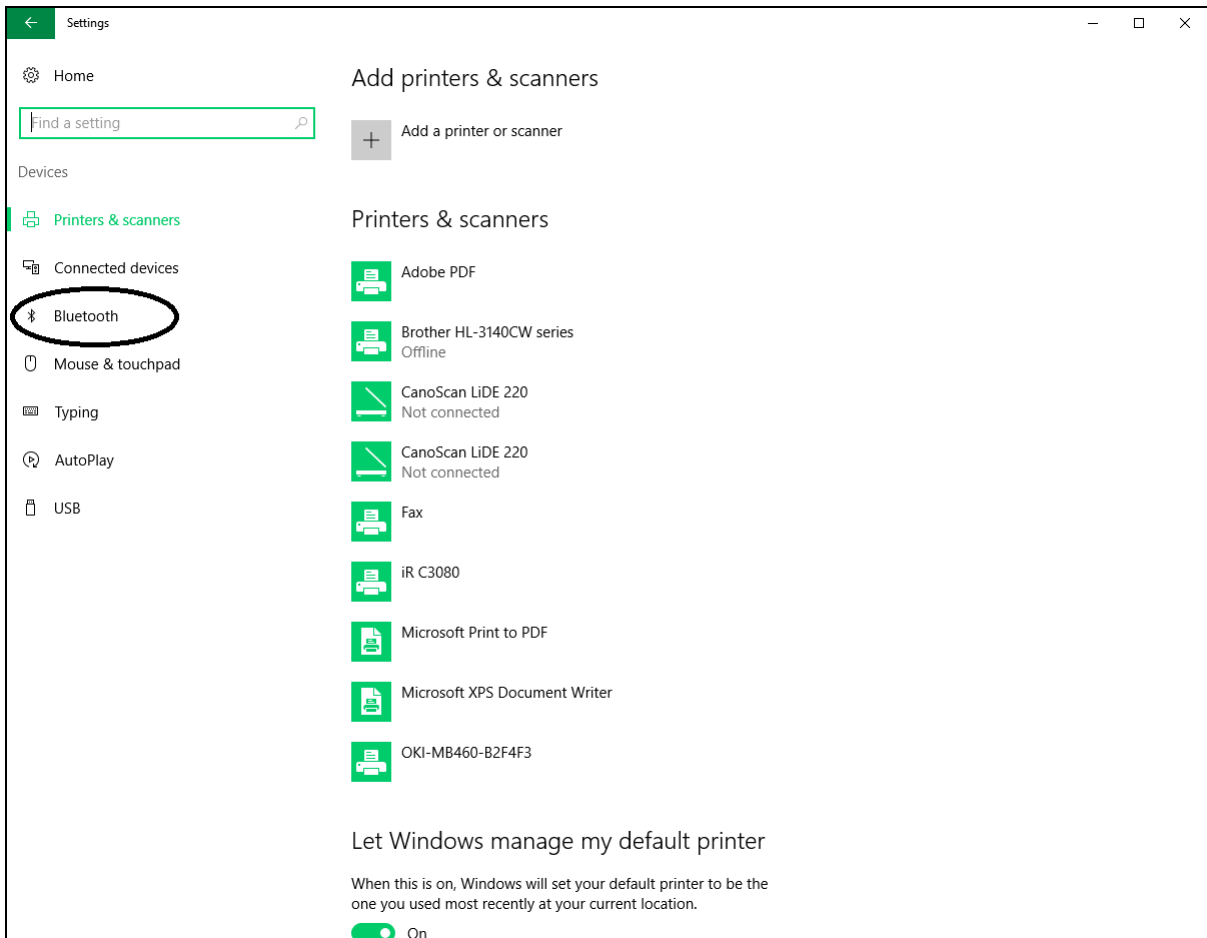
- Click the Start menu on the PC
- Select the icon that looks like a cog to go to the settings menu



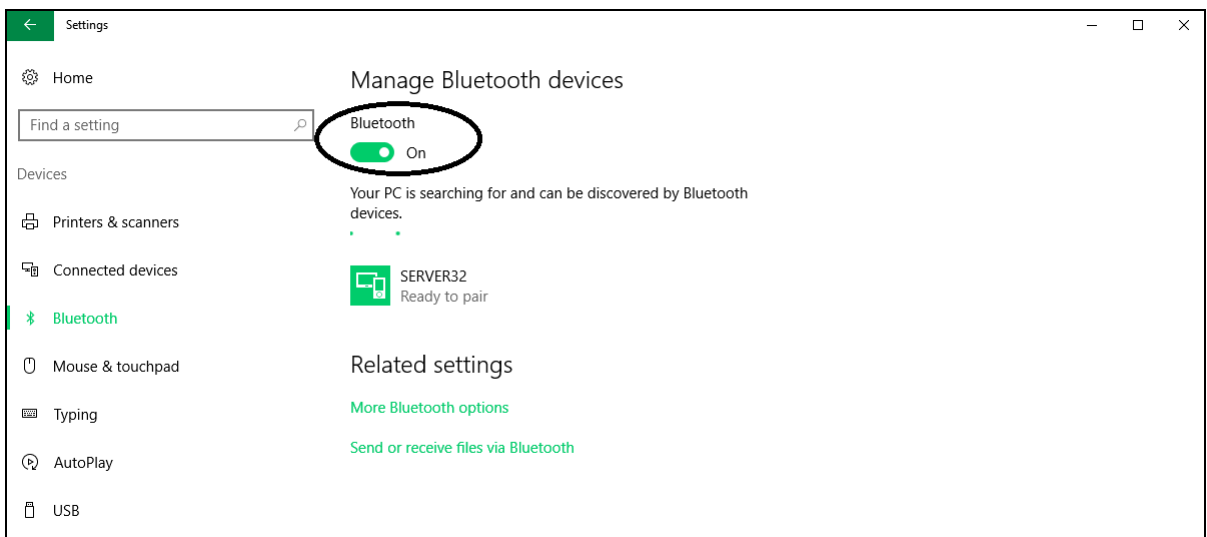
- Click on the section that is titled 'Devices'



- On the left select 'Bluetooth'

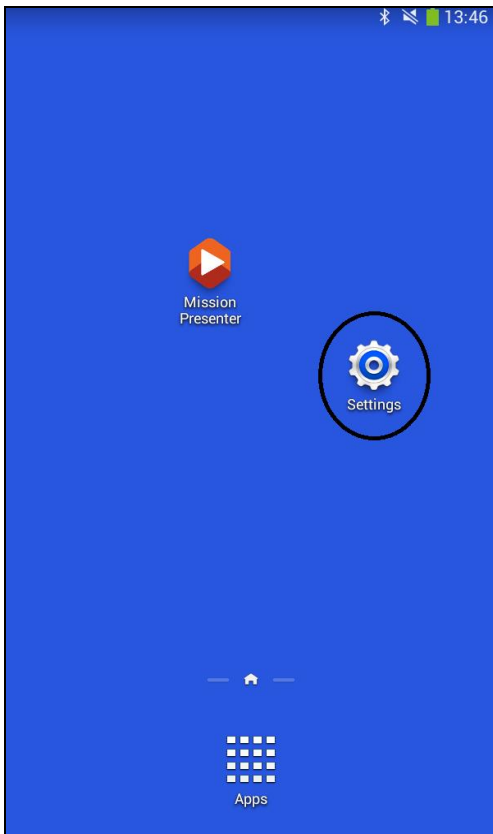


- Turn on the toggle for the Bluetooth if it is not already set to on

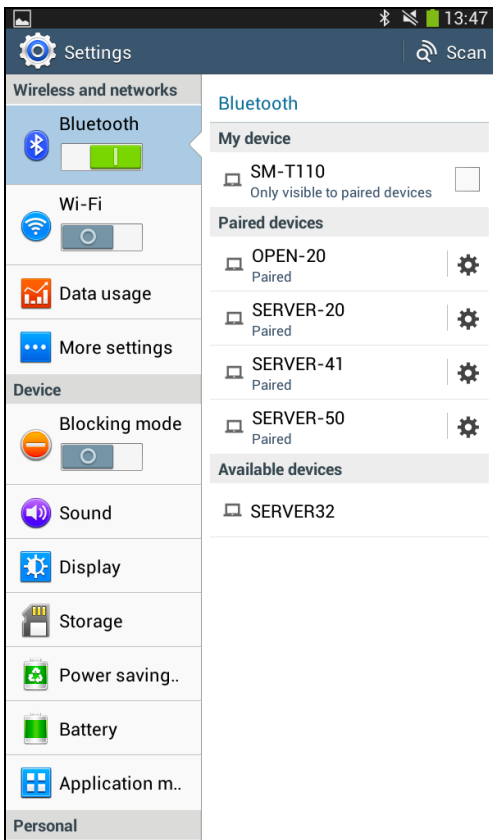


- Turn on the tablet

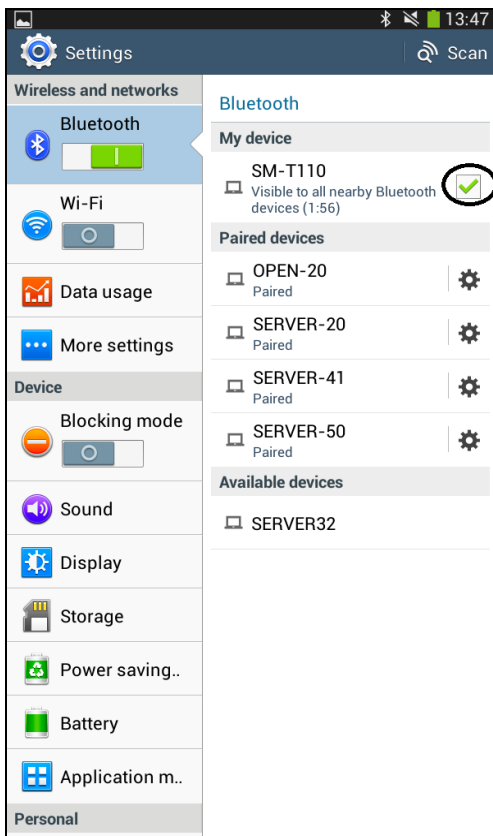
- Click on 'Settings'



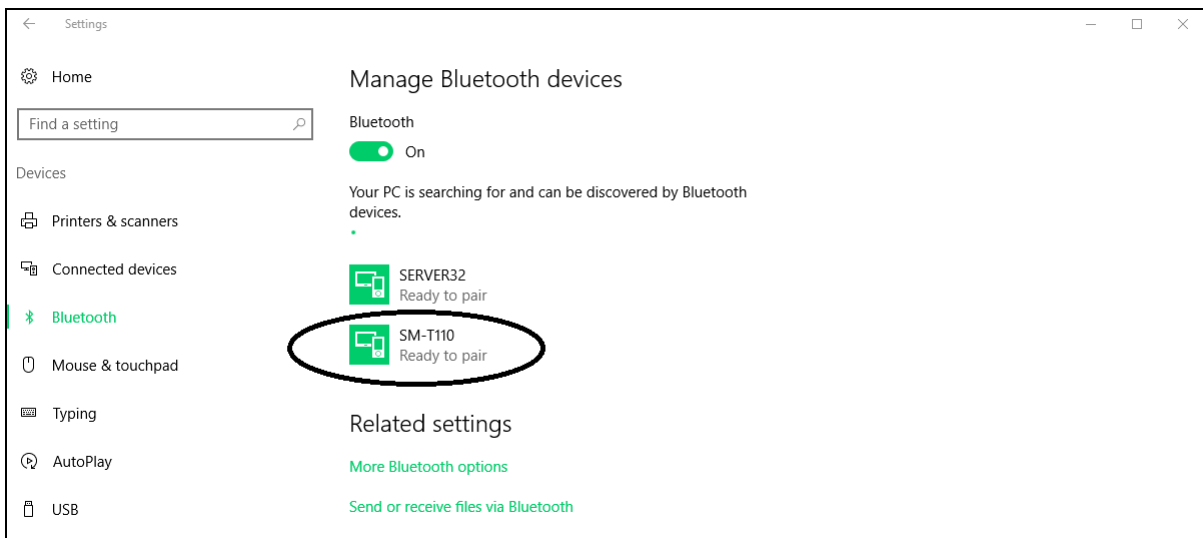
- Select the 'Bluetooth' section on the left and ensure that the toggle is set to on



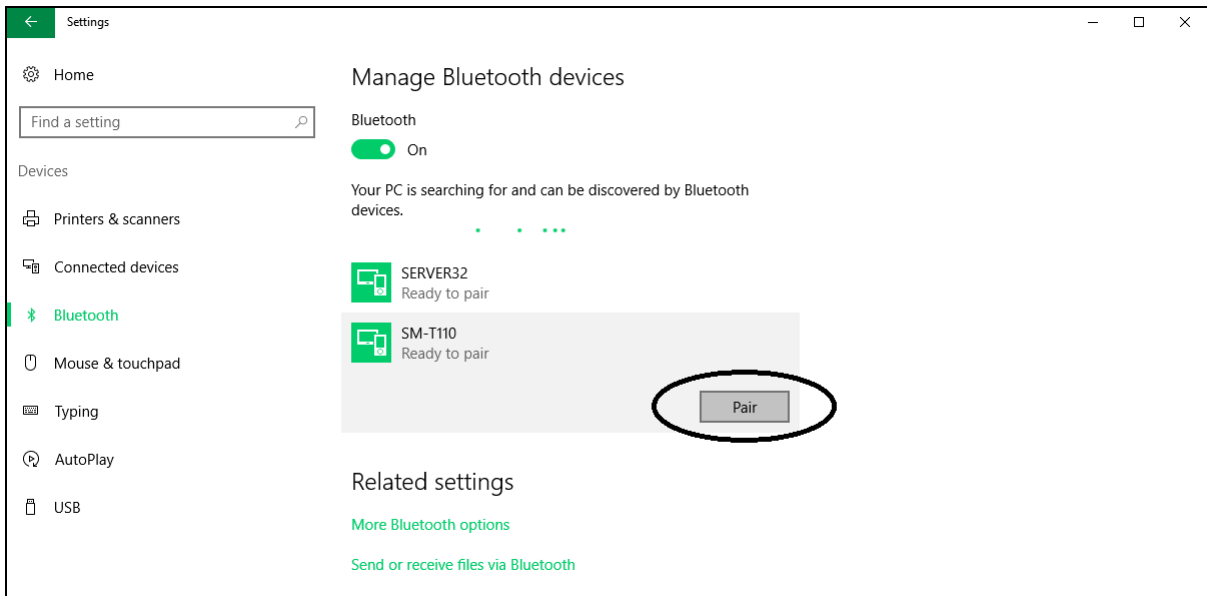
- Check the box next to device in the 'My device' section to turn on device visibility



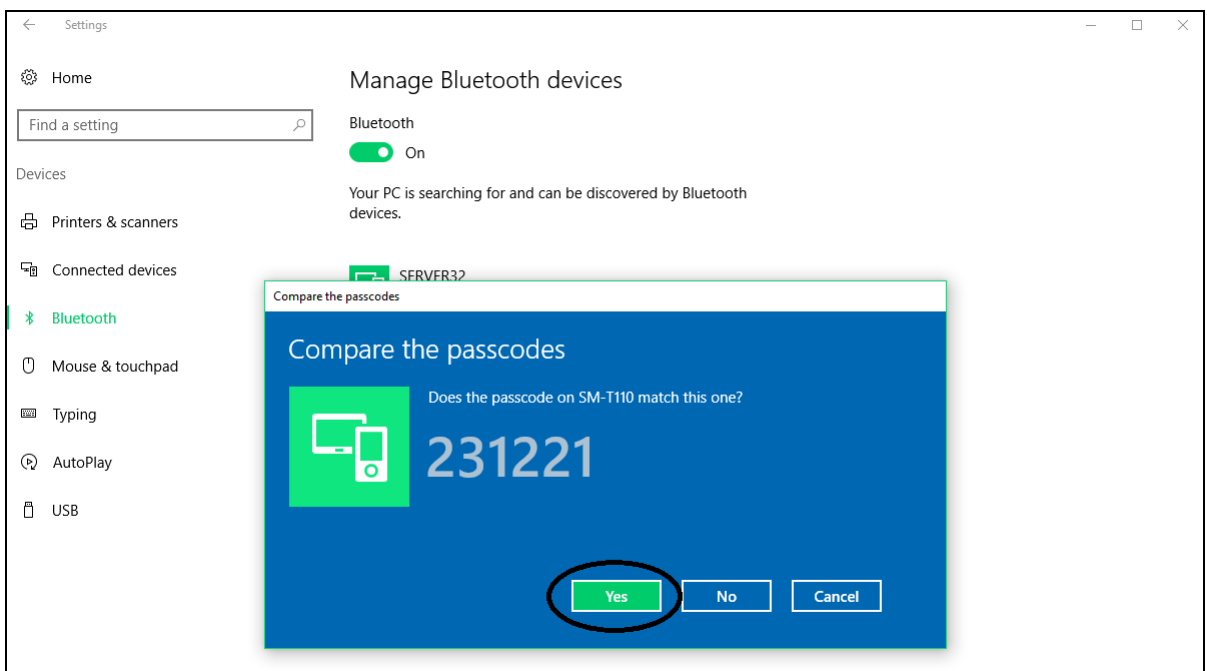
- On the PC the device will now appear stating that it is 'Ready to Pair'



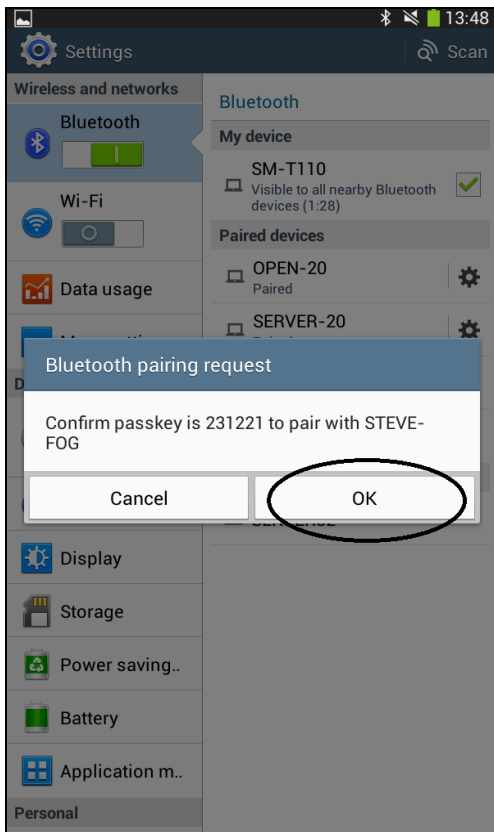
- Click the device on the PC and select 'Pair'



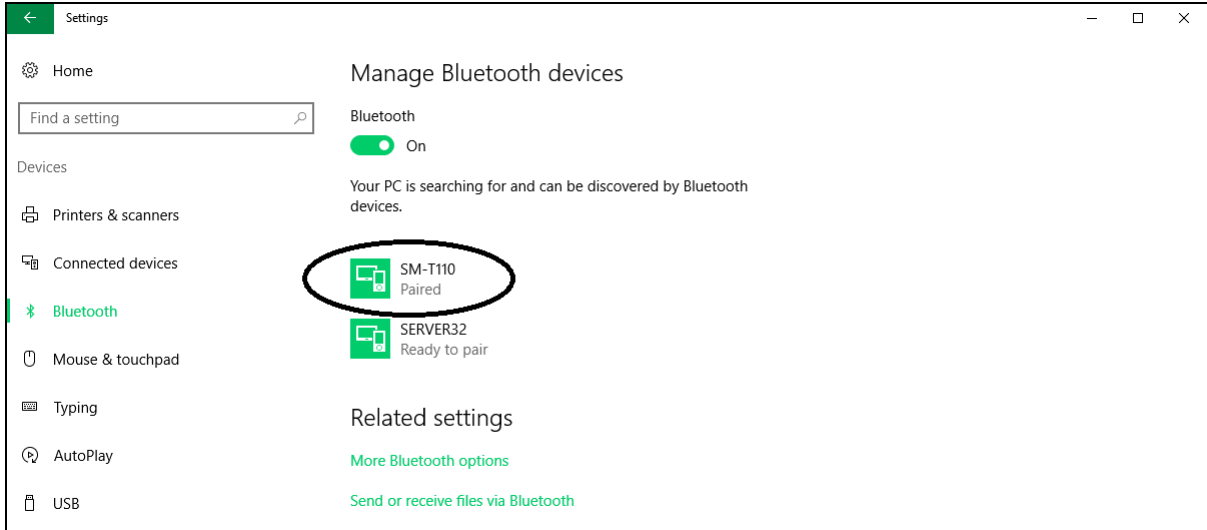
- A passkey/passcode will be displayed on the screen of the tablet and PC



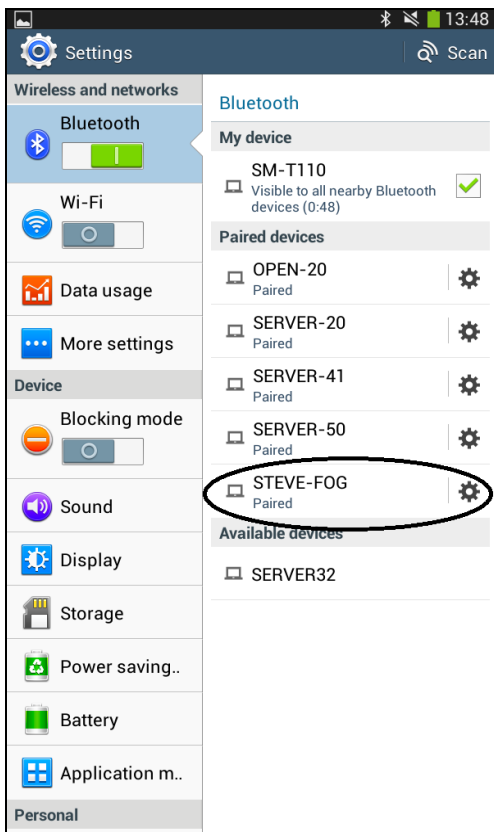
- Confirm that these are the same and tap 'OK' on the tablet and 'Yes' on the PC



- The device will now be shown as 'Paired' on the PC

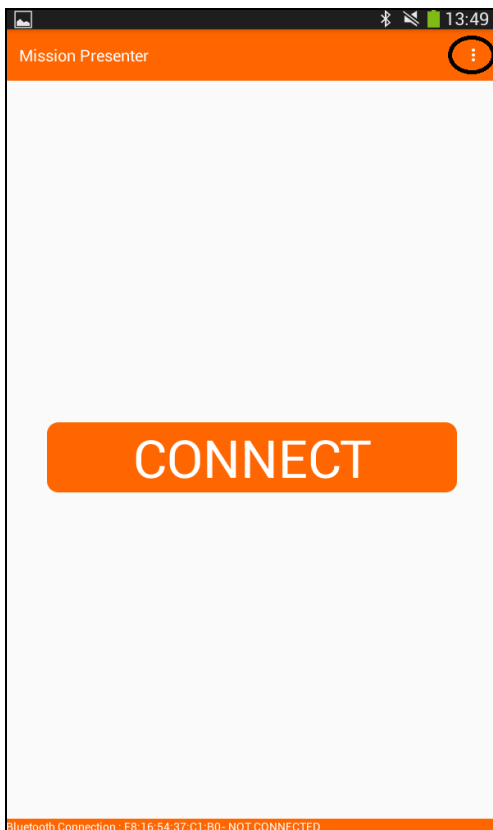


- The PC name will now show up as 'Paired' under the 'Paired devices' section on the tablet

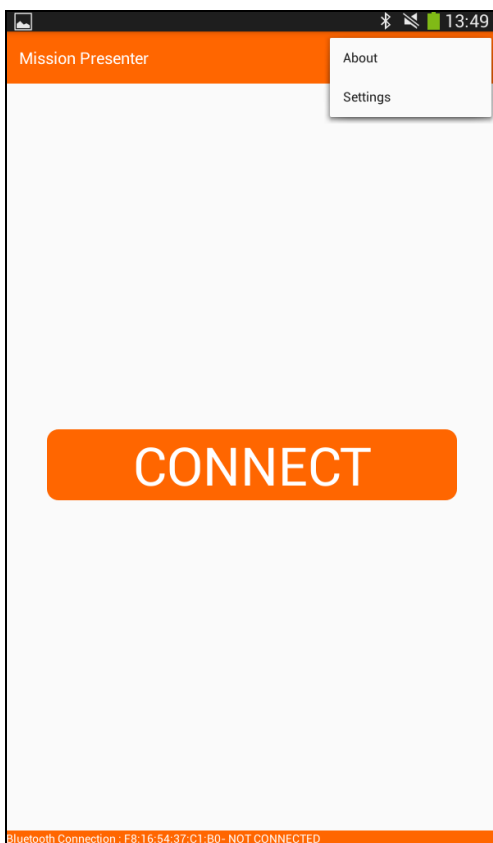


- Click on the Mission Presenter shortcut on the tablet home screen

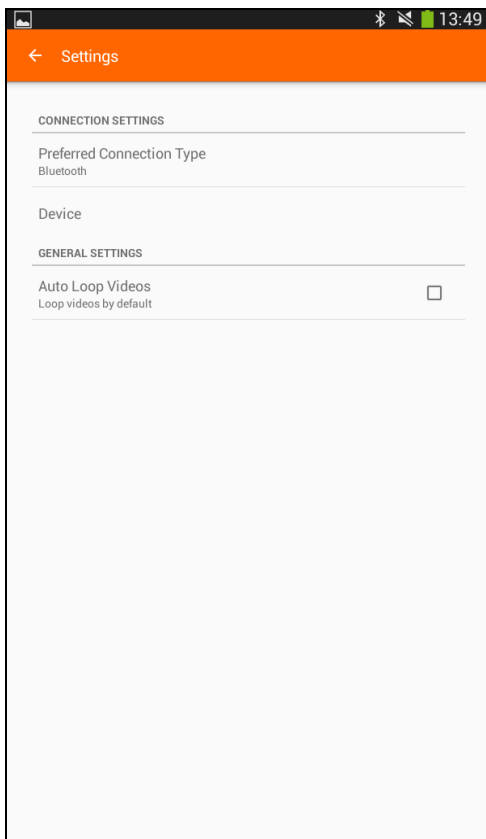
- When the program has started tap the 3 dots in the top right



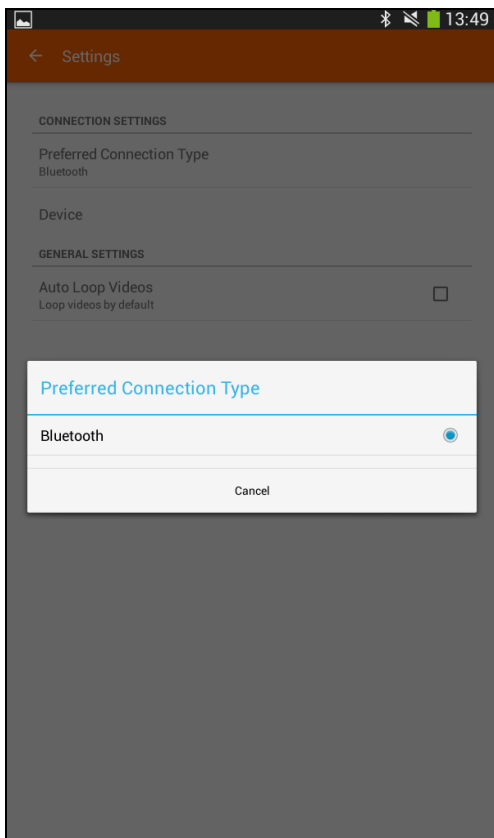
- Select 'Settings'



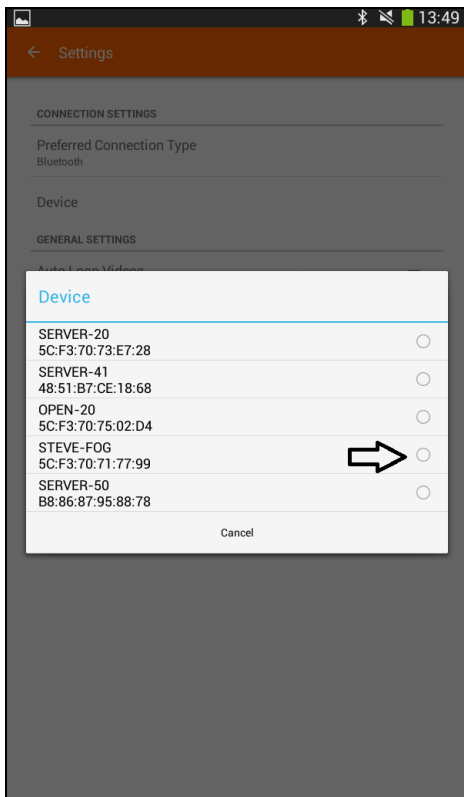
- On the next screen tap on 'Preferred Connection Type'



- Select 'Bluetooth'



- Next tap on 'Device'
- A list of paired devices will be shown, tap the circle next to the device that you are trying to control



- The name of the selected device will be shown under the 'Device' section
